Consultants to the Board

The Board may utilize the services of professional consultants in an advisory or an evaluative role when it is deemed in the best interest of the District to do so.

Professional consultants such as the Board attorney, architect and auditor shall possess appropriate professional training and experience, as determined by the Board. They shall be properly licensed to perform the particular professional service and be members in good standing of such professional organizations as are customary for practitioners in these fields.

All professional consultants employed by the Board shall immediately advise the Superintendent of disciplinary proceedings instituted against them in connection with their professional activities, whether brought by a licensing agency or professional organization. The Board shall determine whether such proceedings undermine the confidence necessarily placed in the consultant by the Board.
