Accentuate the Negative Vocabulary



Vocabulary Word	Definition	Example
Absolute Value	The absolute value of a number is its distance from 0 on a number line. It can be thought of as the value of a number when its sign is ignored.	
Expense, loss	Expenses are the costs produced while doing business, including cost of merchandise sold, rent on a building, and wages for employees. Loss is the amount the business is "short" if expenses exceed income.	
Income, profit	Income is the amount of money a business takes in. Profit is the amount left over from income after expenses are subtracted.	
Inequality	An inequality is similar to an equation in that there are two expressions separated by a symbol that indicates how one expression is related to the other. In an inequality, the symbol is anything other than an equal sign.	
Integer	Whole numbers and their opposites.	
Inverse operations	Operations that "undo" each other or the opposite operations.	
Negative integer	A whole number less than 0.	
Negative Number	On a number line, negative numbers are located to the left of 0 (on a vertical number line, negative numbers are located below 0).	
Number sentence	It gives the relationship between two expressions, which are composed of numbers and operation signs.	
Opposites	Two numbers that add to 0 are opposites. On a number line, opposites are the same distance from 0 but in different directions from 0. The number 0 is its own opposite.	
Positive integer	A whole number greater than 0. (The number 0 is neither positive nor negative.)	
Positive number	On a number line, positive numbers are located to the right of 0 (on a vertical number line, positive numbers are located above 0).	
Quadrant	The quadrants are the four sections into which the coordinate plane is divided.
