Dear Keeneyville District 20 Families,

We have now completed three weeks of full day, in-person learning, and we want to thank our families and staff for following the District 20 health and safety protocols which are aligned with state and local COVID-19 guidelines. We are very pleased that since we began in-person instruction in October, we have seen a low number of students with confirmed cases of COVID-19. We need to continue to work together to maintain a safe school community as we finish out the remaining weeks of the school year.

- It is essential that you complete your child(ren)'s health assessment and <u>certification card</u>, each and every day. If your child has <u>any</u> of the COVID-19 related symptoms below within the previous 24 hours, your <u>child must stay home</u>, and you need to report the absence and reasons to your school:
 - \circ Fever of 100.4F or higher
 - New onset of moderate to severe headache
 - o Shortness of breath
 - New cough or sore throat
 - Vomiting or diarrhea
 - New loss of sense of taste or smell
 - Fatigue from unknown cause
 - Muscle or body aches from unknown cause
- If your child experiences symptoms during the school day, the nurse will conduct an evaluation and contact you to pick-up your child if needed. We continue to strongly recommend seeking medical care and/or testing if the symptoms appear to be related to COVID-19. Please see the D20 COVID-19 Protocols & FAQs for current procedures, which are consistent with recently updated IDPH, ISBE and DCHD guidelines.
